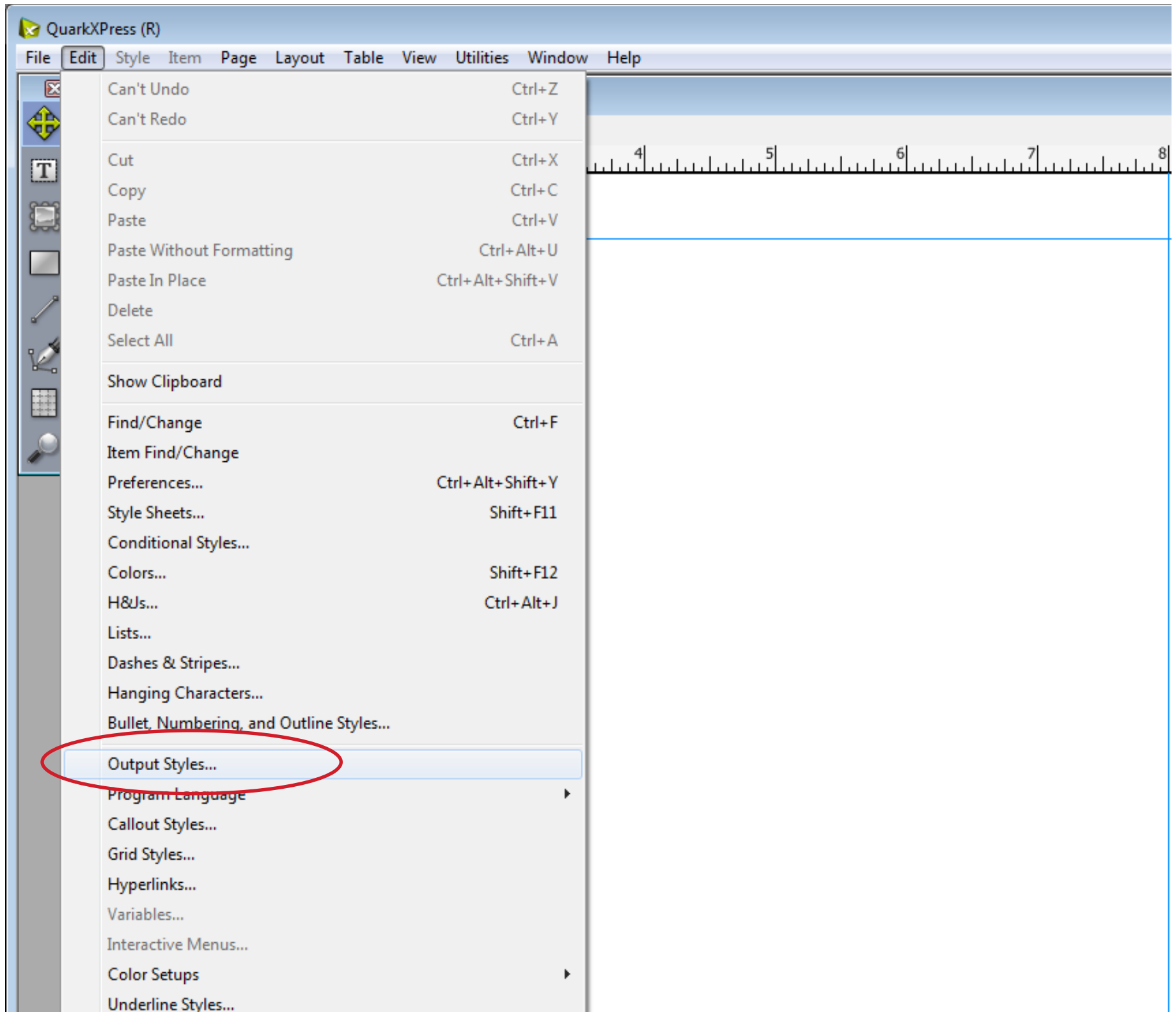
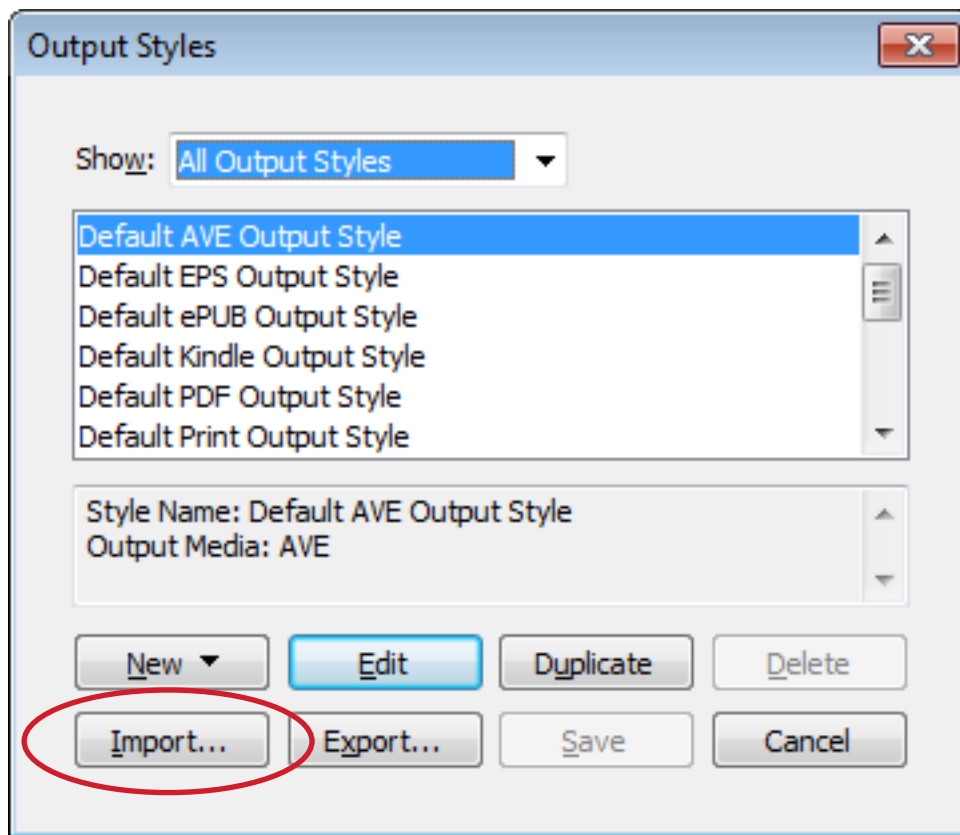


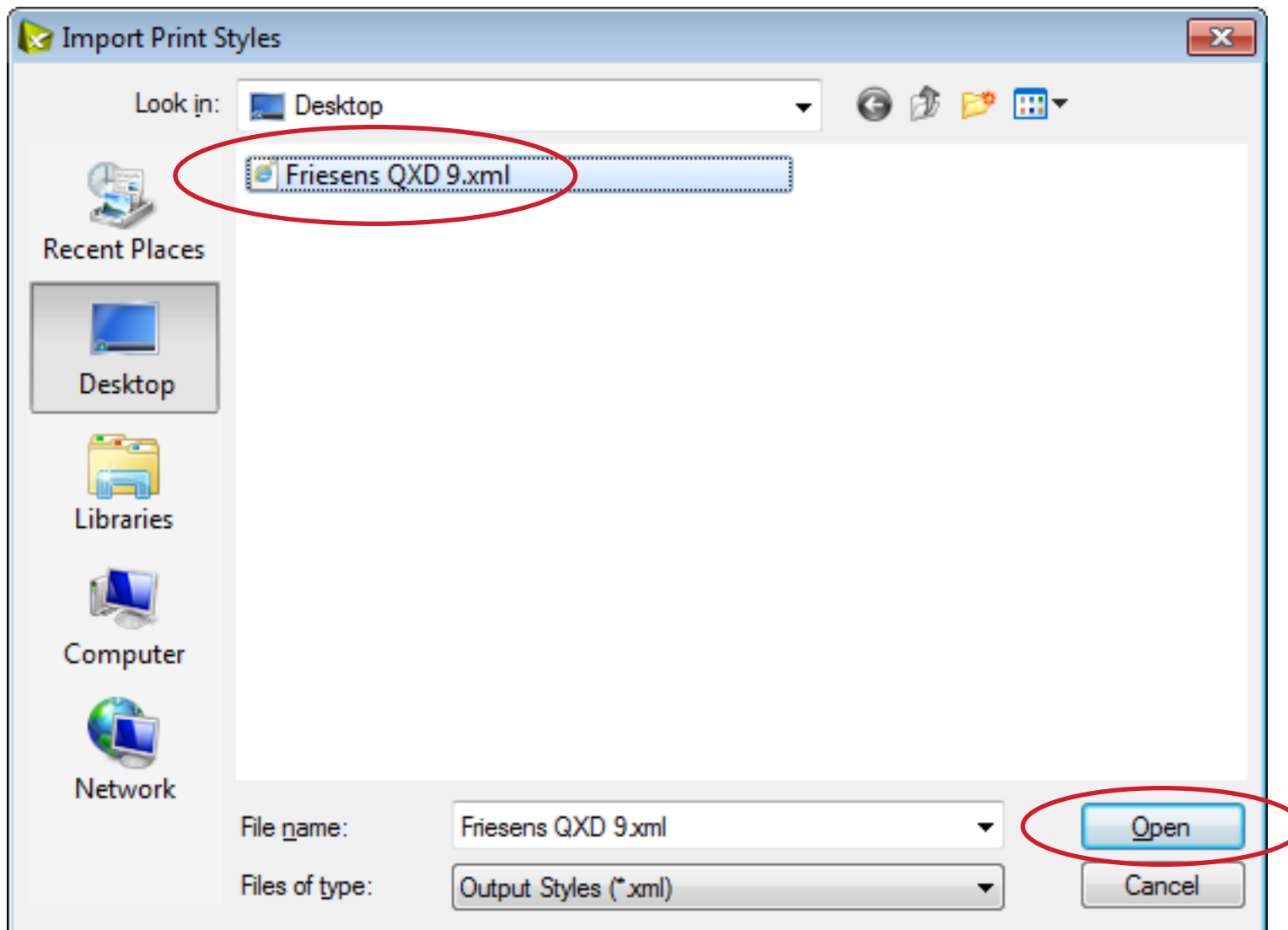
The first step to create a PDF is to load the Friesens PDF settings. Choose Edit, Output Styles... from the menu.



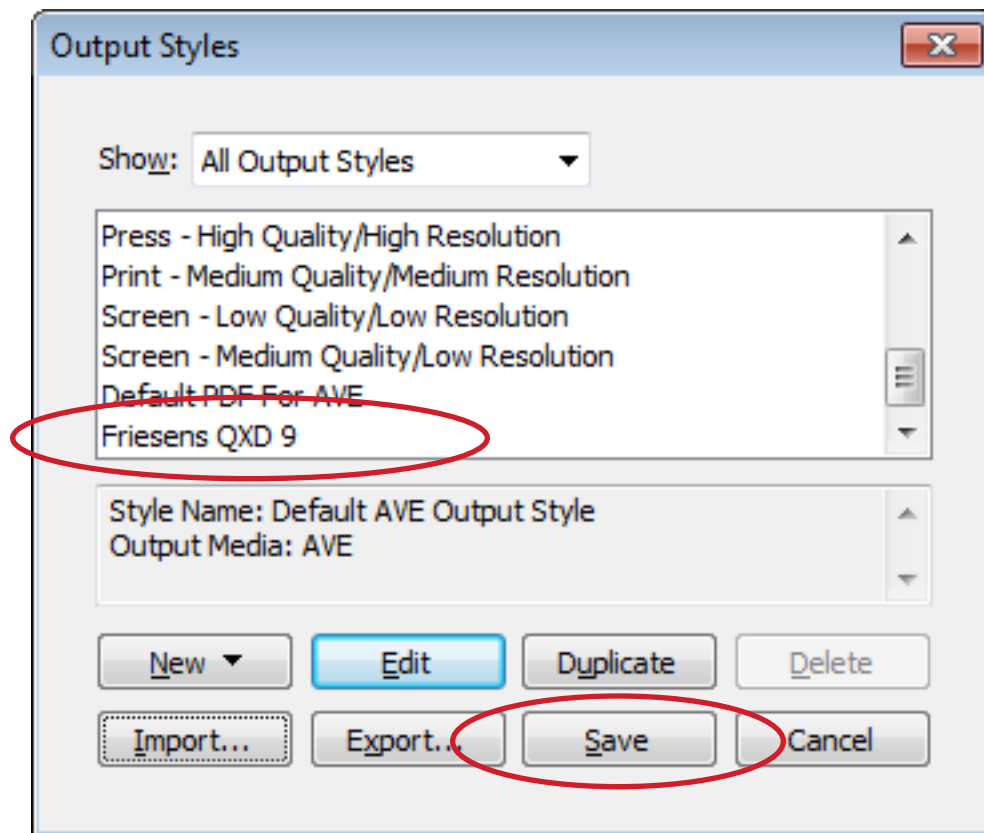
Next press the Import... button.



Locate the Friesens QXD 9.xml Output Style and press the Open button.



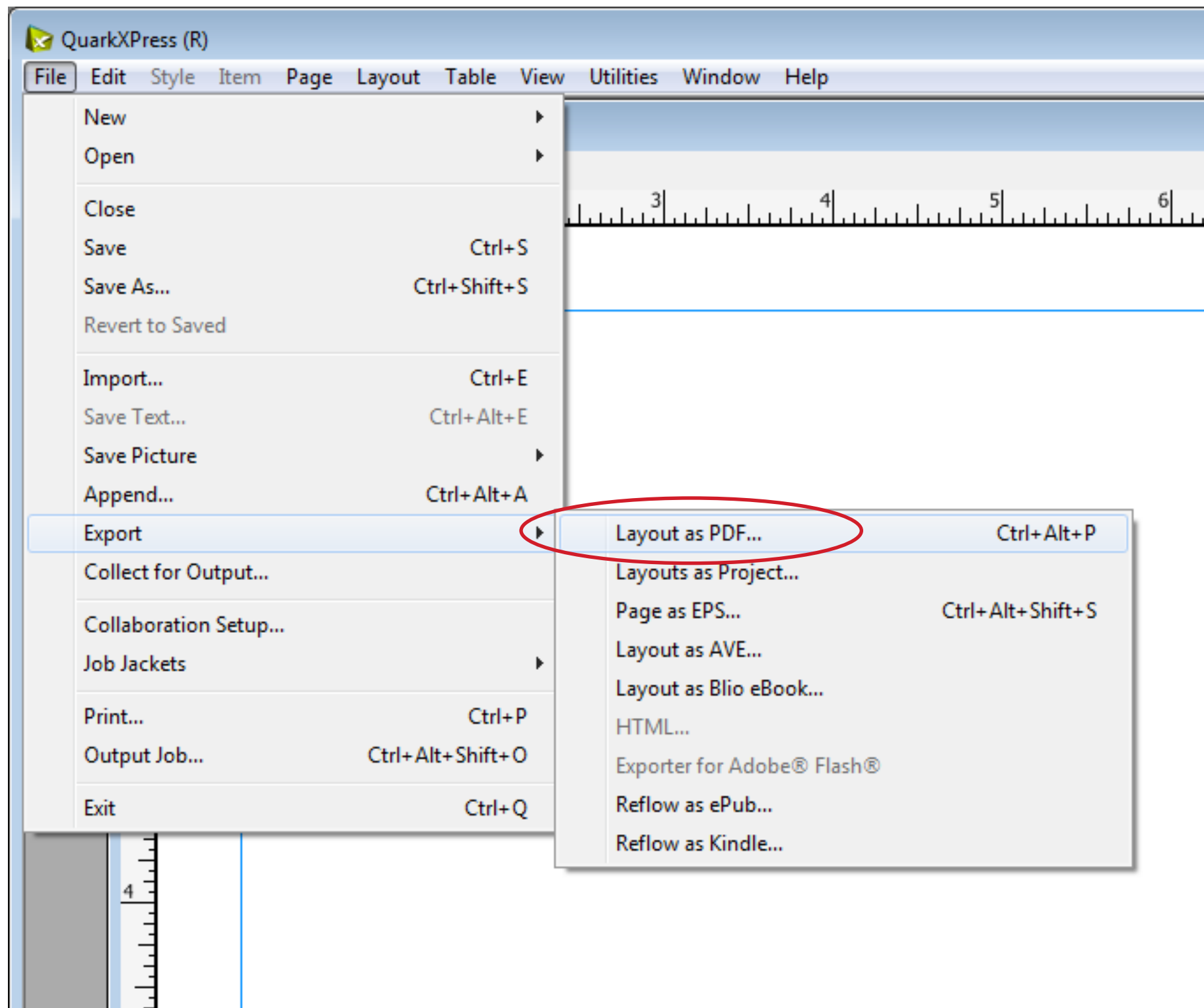
Next press the Save button.



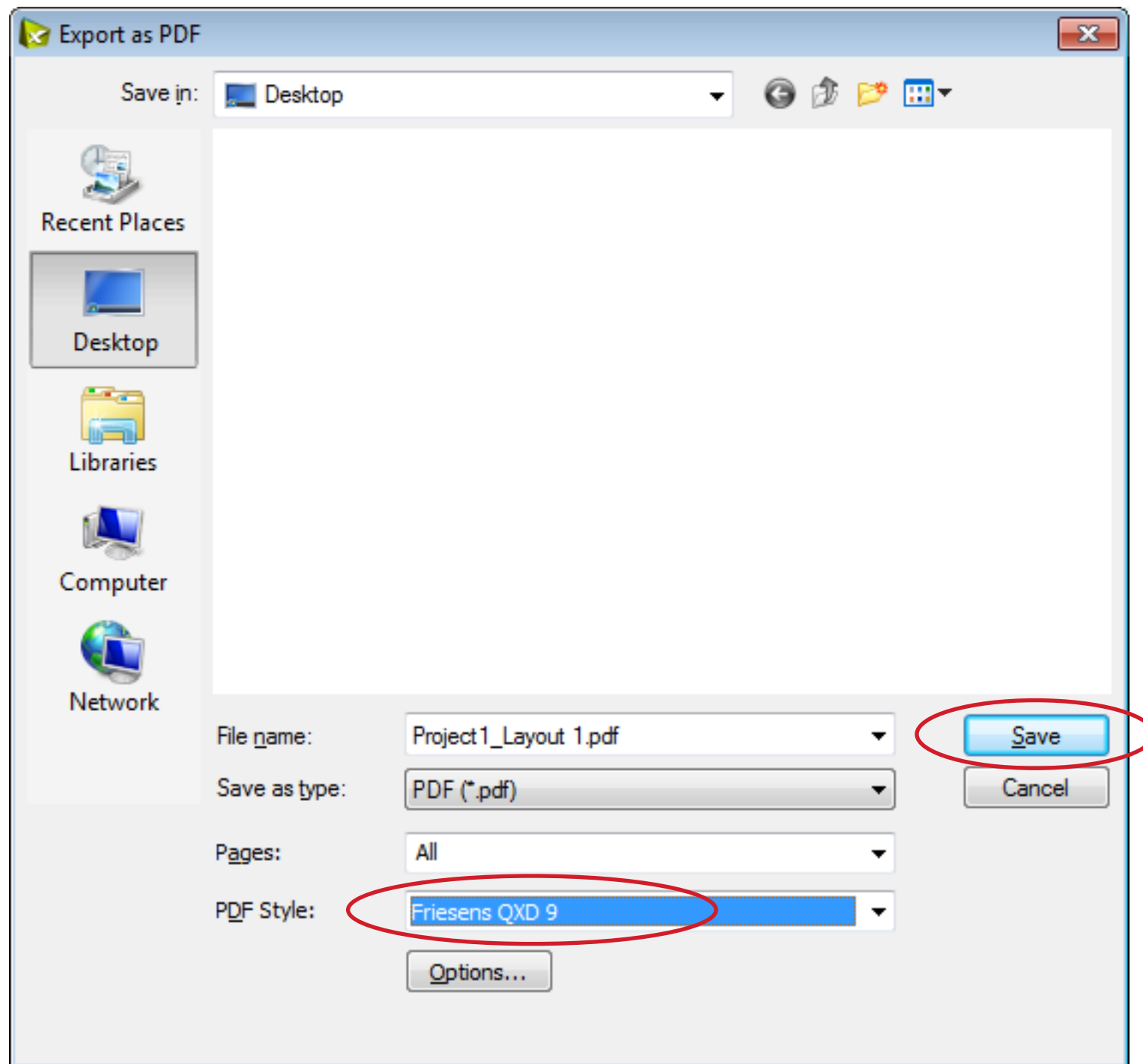
The Friesens PDF export settings are now available for use in QuarkXPress.

Now that the Friesens PDF settings are loaded use the following steps to create a PDF file.

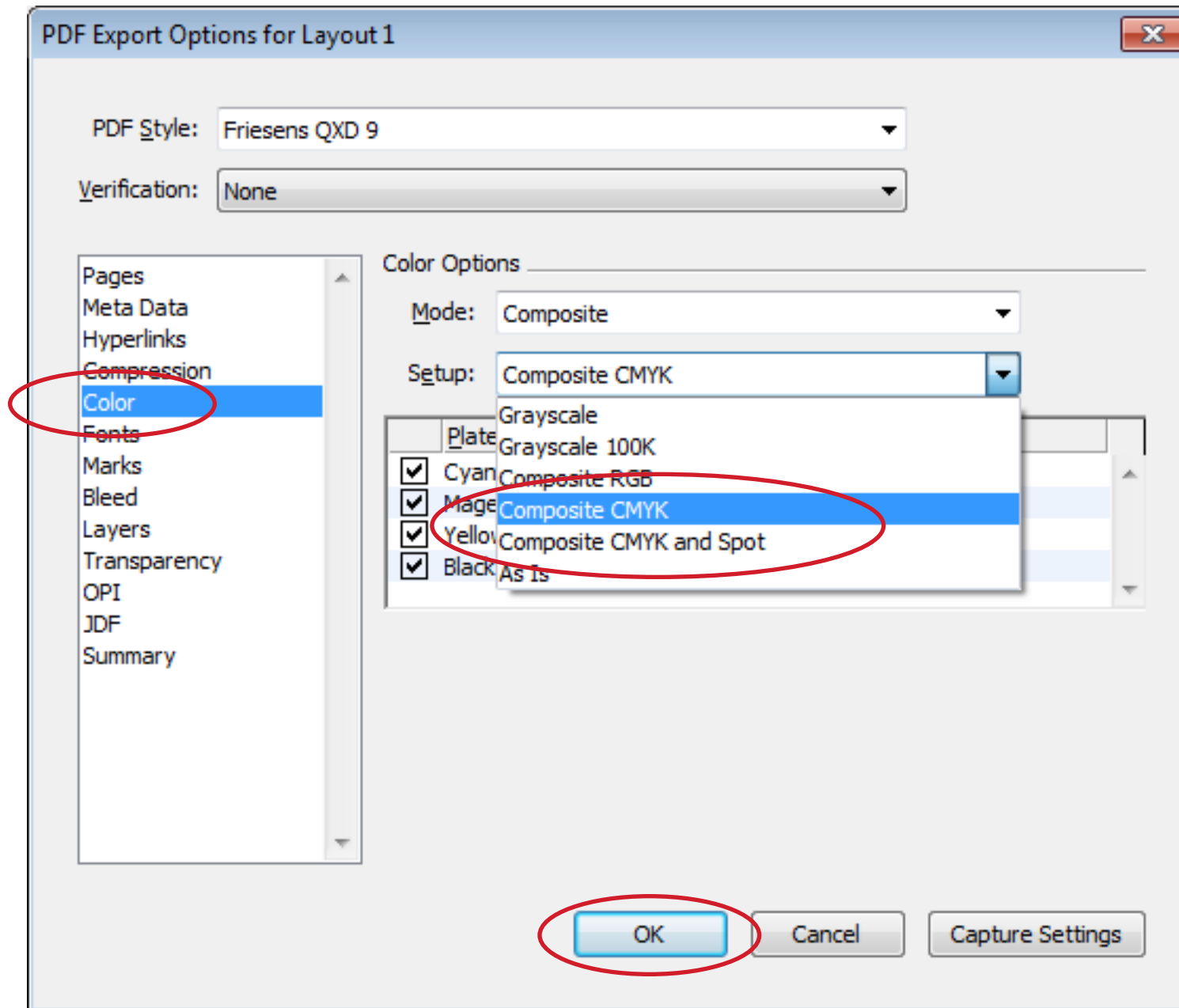
Choose File, Export, Layout as PDF... from the menu.



Select a name and location for your PDF file.

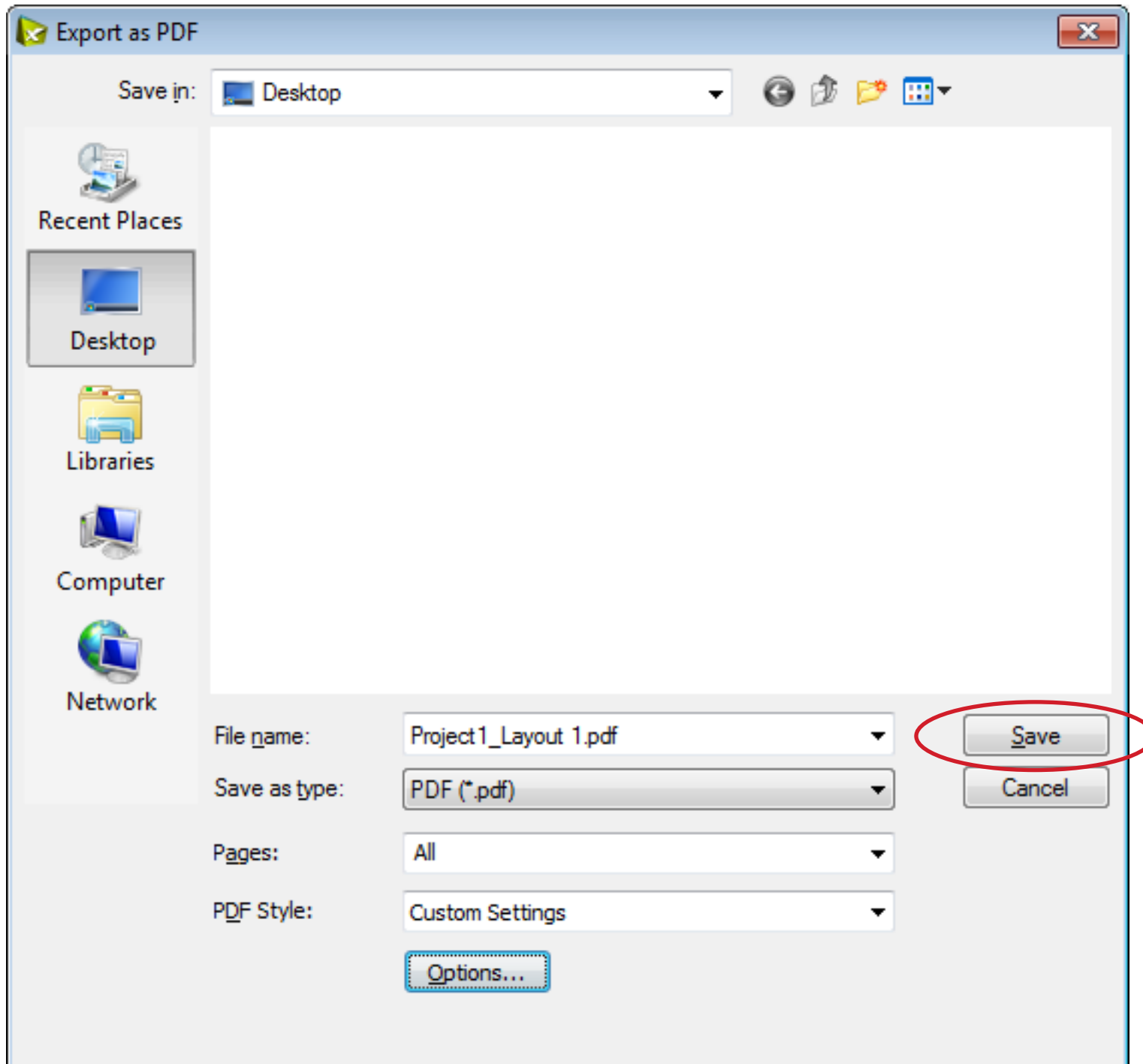


Select Friesens QXD 9 from the PDF Style. For documents that contain CMYK or Grayscale press the Save button. For Duotones or spot colours press Options... and select the following settings.



In the Color section choose Composite CMYK for CMYK or Grayscale documents. For Duotones or spot colours choose Composite CMYK and Spot. Press the OK button to save this selection.

Select a name and location for your PDF file.



Press the Save button to export your PDF file.
