DO

HALLOWEEN

Use decorative fonts as graphic elements to enhance page content.

Avoid long copy blocks of bold or all caps, and avoid all caps when using a script font.

BODY

All type is meant to be read. Make sure your story is set in a clearly readable font.

Never change font size or leading within a section.

Serif fonts in 10–12 pt are best for body copy.

Choose a font that includes a bold and italic version for your body copy.

Black type on a white background is easiest to read.

HEADLINES

Choose 3 main fonts for consistency. One each for headlines, body copy, and captions.

Use decorative fonts as graphic elements only.

Headlines should be set in at least 30 pts, in serif or sans serif fonts. Use "decorative" fonts sparingly.

CAPTIONS

Choose a sans serif font set in 8–9 pt for easy to read captions.
